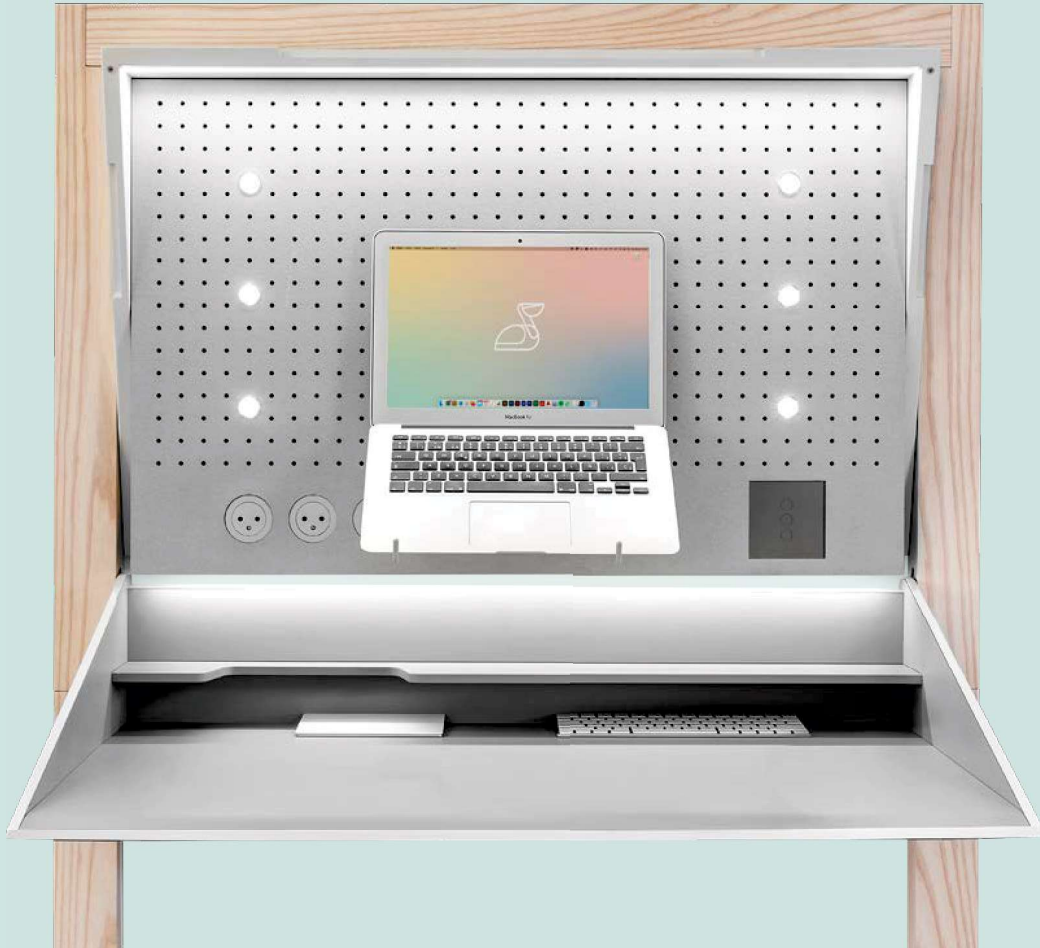

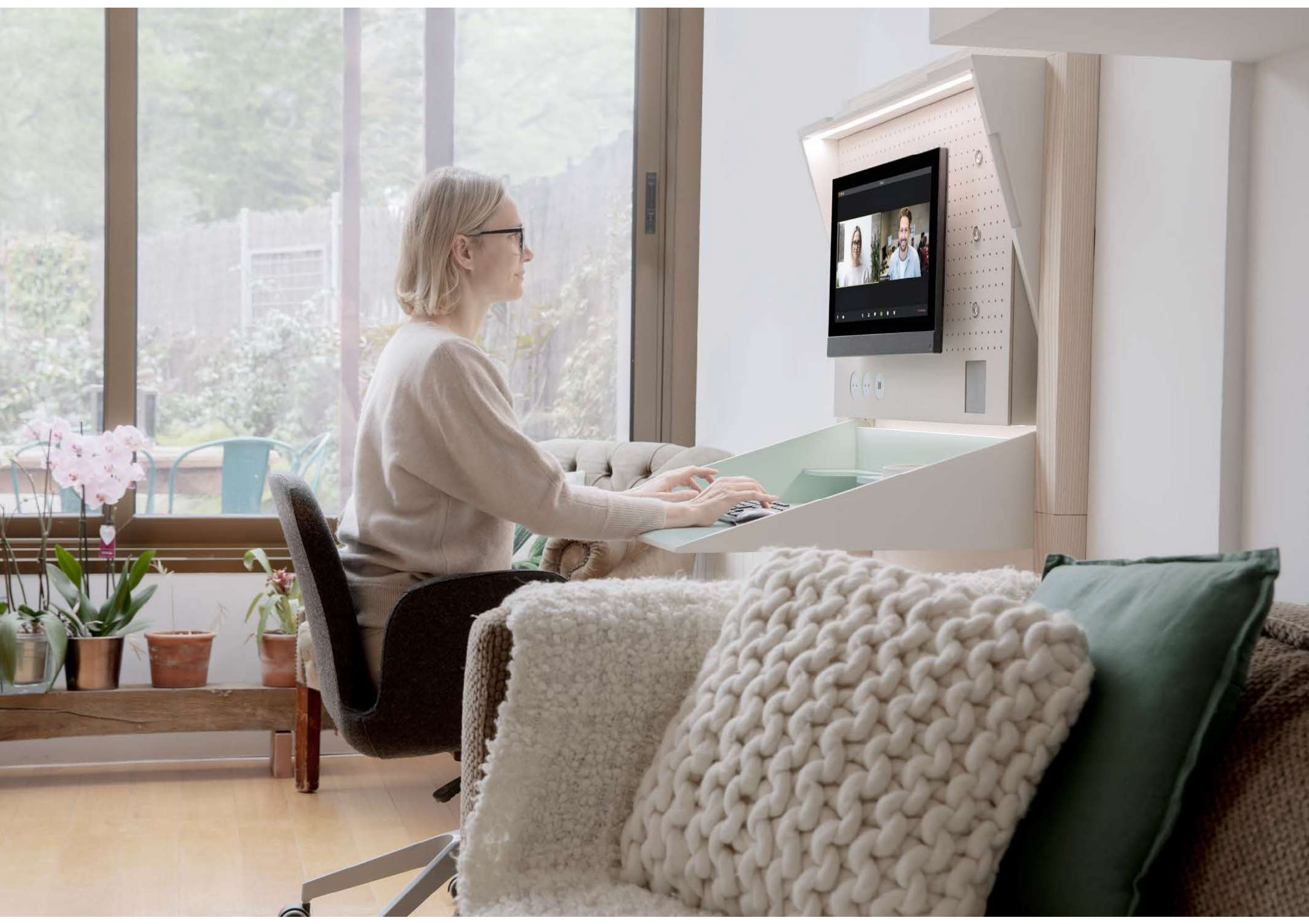
Our aim is to provide anyone working from home with a more comfortable, safe, and healthy environment, and to equip companies with an essential tool that helps bridge the office-home gap.

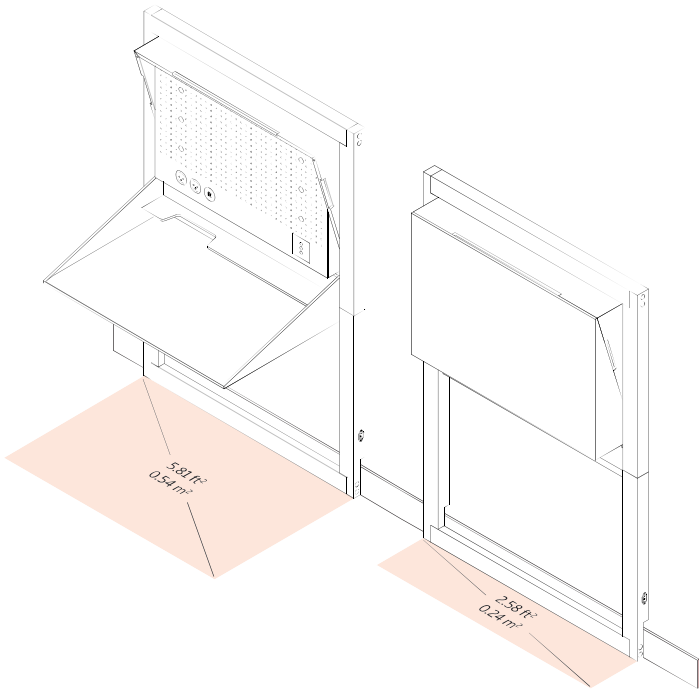
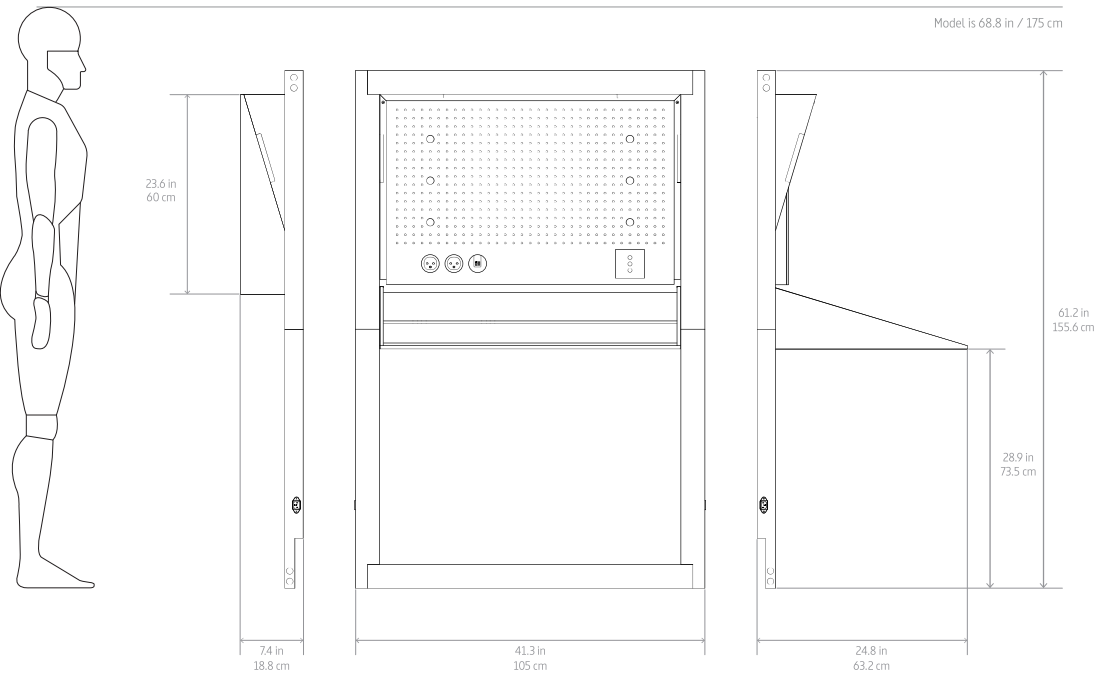

Control panel: The sustainable cork panel has great acoustic properties, and the perforated surface allows you to use our accessories to adjust devices and documents to your eye level. It serves as a base for sockets, videoconferencing lights, and lighting controls.



Work surface: Our antibacterial, anti-reflective material makes it safe, and easy to clean. Its proportions and technical specifications adhere to the latest standards, technical requirements, and regulations that help prevent occupational hazards.

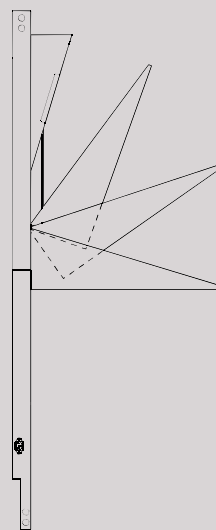

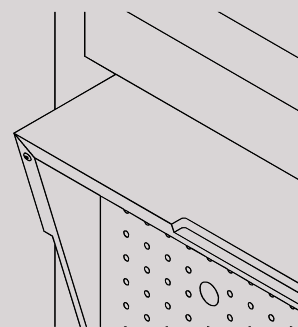

A soft open mechanism built into both sides of the wooden frame cushions the opening when the work surface is unfolded.



The frame and housing have a built-in magnetic locking system that, when opened or closed, allows the articulated parts to remain fixed, providing security and simplicity during the assembly process and in daily use.

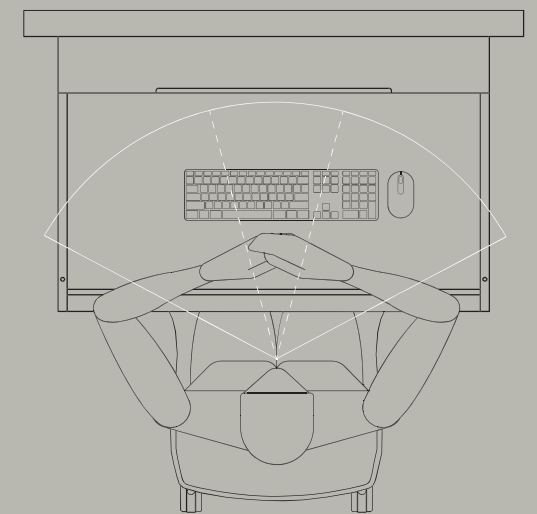
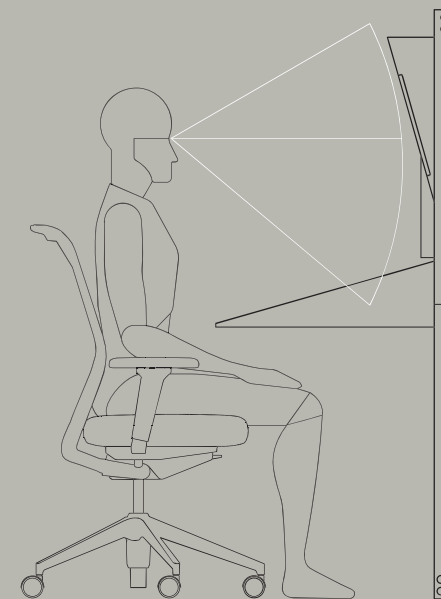
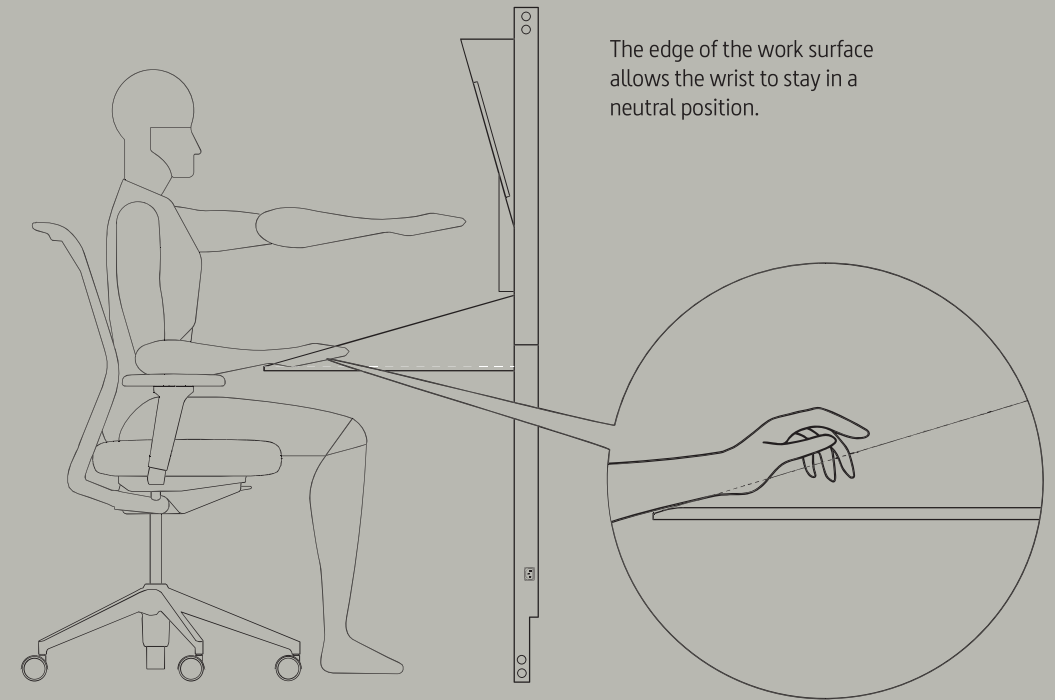
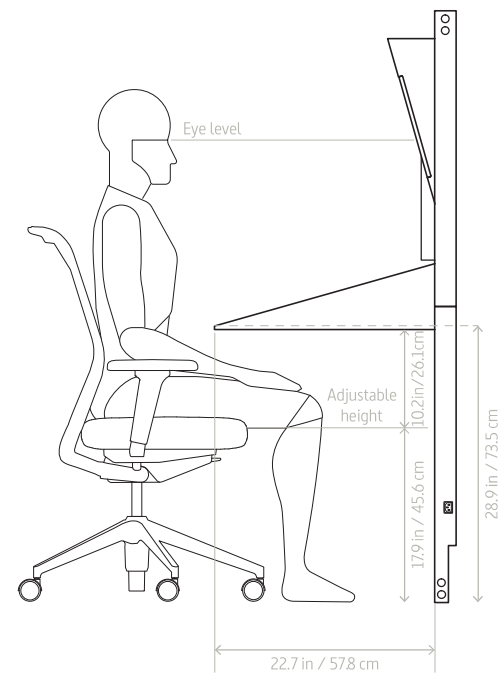
03 Ergonomic design.

These allow the user to place all desktop items and workstation components within optimal reach, making it easier to adopt ergonomic postures and comfort angles for the various parts of the body.

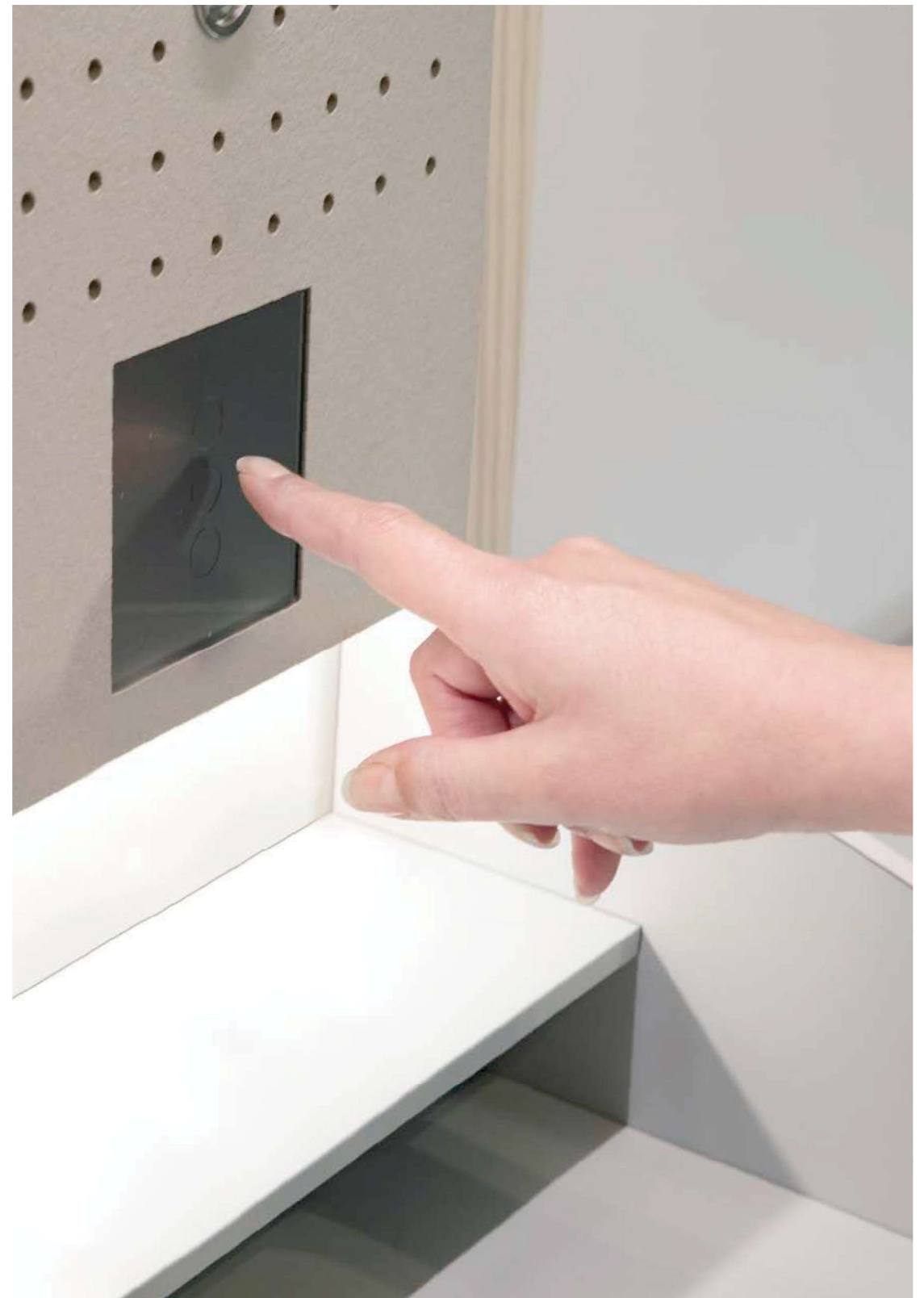
Beaktor makes the day-to-day interaction between user and workstation as comfortable and intuitive as possible, always connected to innovation and the needs of remote working.

03 Lighting.

Lighting is one of Beaktor's defining characteristics. The upper section has a carefully positioned light source that provides a uniform distribution of light across the work surface.

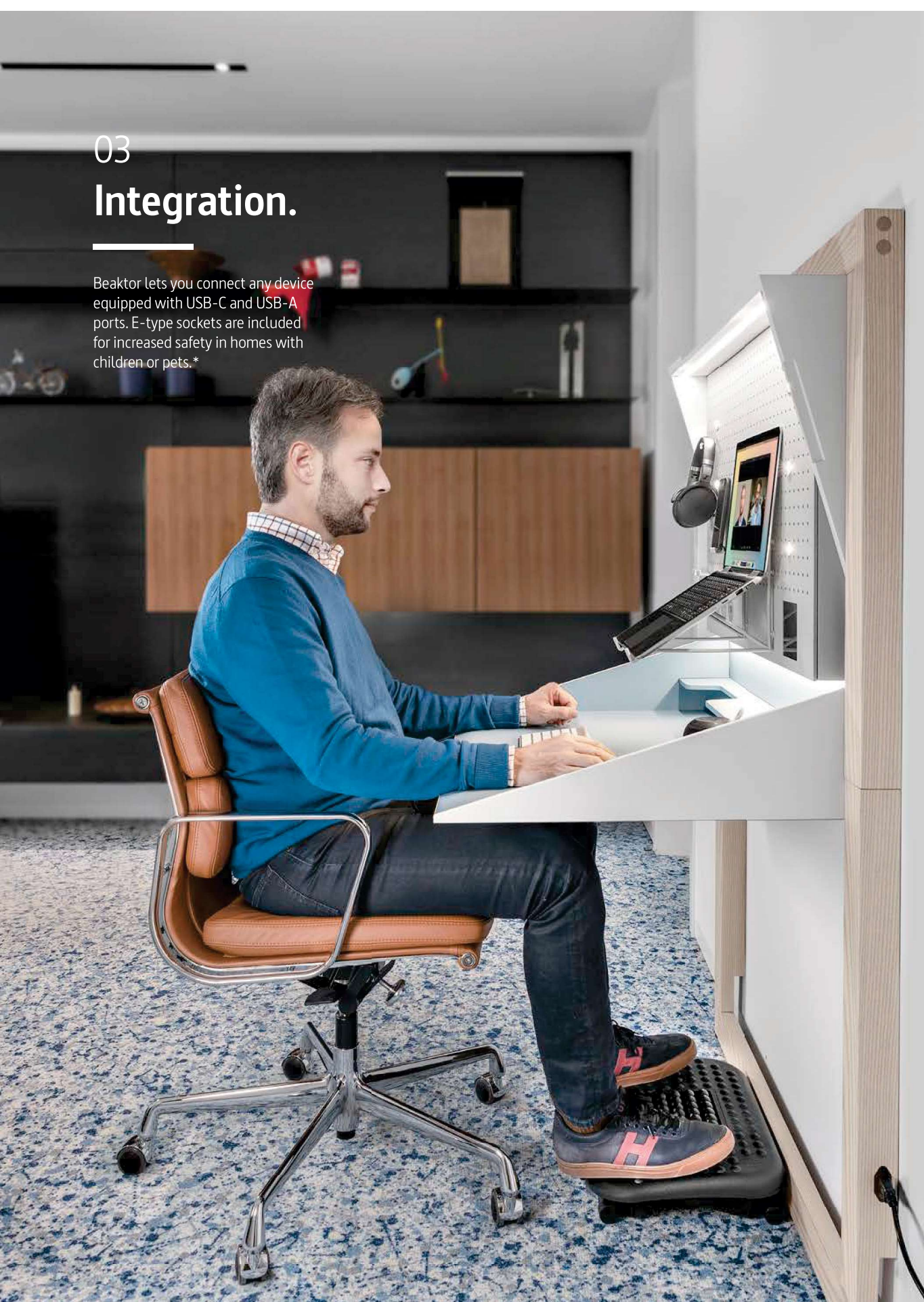
Six built-in LED lights on the Conference model control panel optimise lighting when making video calls.

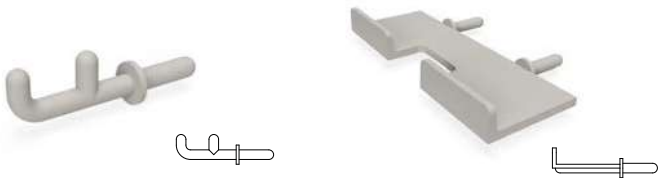

03 Accessories.

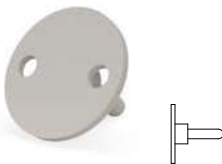
Beaktor's control panel is completely adjustable. It can accommodate different accessories designed to fit the perforated surface, supporting screens, mobiles, tablets, documents, and other lightweight desktop items.



HOOK
Multipurpose F-shaped supports are perfect for holding mobiles, tablets, and paper documents at a height best suited the user.



ANCHOR
Useful for positioning mobiles and tablets, the central opening allows you to connect your charger without having to remove it from the holder.



DOT
Dot allows you to add a personal touch by using your favourite objects such as mirrors, photo frames or clipboards.
You can use screws or adhesive, it's your choice.



LAPDECK
Designed to offer greater ergonomics and keep laptop screens at eye level, it helps avoid muscle contractions and potential cervical injuries. It should be accompanied by a keyboard and mouse, or trackpad.

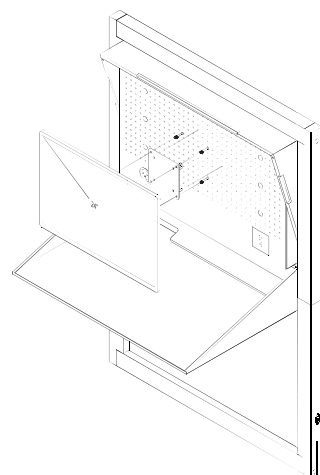


03 BigPicture.

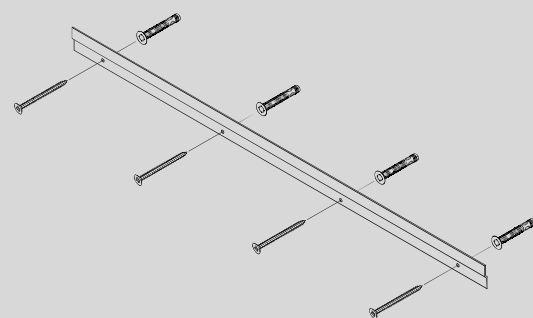
STEP 01



MARK THE HEIGHT

Using a pencil and the 53.3 in (138 cm) ruler found inside the packaging, mark both ends of the plate bracket, so it is level. Once level, mark the holes through the plate. Any sockets should be no further than 59.1 in (1.5 m) away from either side of the frame.

STEP 02

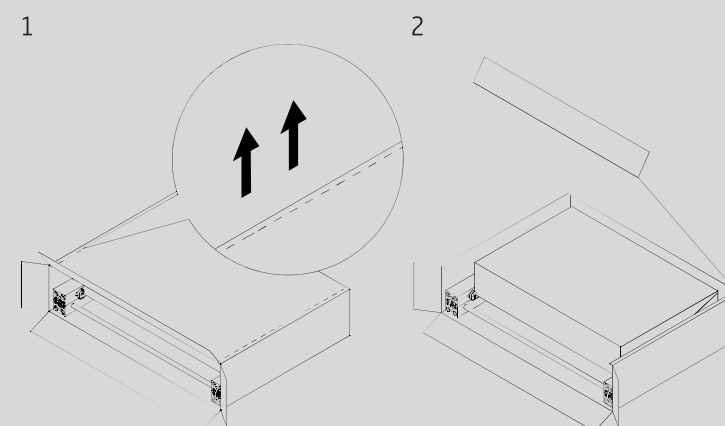


SCREW IN THE PLATE

Once the holes are marked in pencil, use a drill to make the holes in the wall. Insert the wall plugs and fix the plate bracket. *

* The universal plugs included are suitable for fixing into all building materials such as brick, masonry, stud, wood, or other walls and partitions.

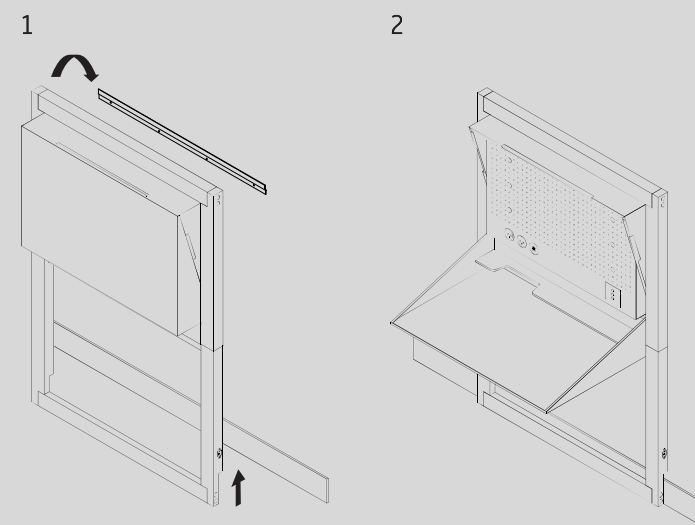
STEP 03



DISCOVER THE CONTENTS

Once the plate bracket has been fixed to the wall, support the box by keeping the cut marks pointing upwards and carefully pull to open the box until the Beaktor is revealed.

STEP 04



HANG BEAKTOR

Supporting both sides, lift the unit and hang it on to the plate bracket, so that it connects with the corresponding plate on Beaktor's reverse. That's it! Connect to the power source, open it up, and customise to your needs.
